Appeals Process

All representations made to the Commission must be in writing, either by post, e-mail or fax. The representation must be as specific as possible.

There are only two grounds on which a representation may state that a local authority has failed to conduct a proper review. These are:

- the local authority has failed to meet the reasonable requirements of the electors in the constituency
- the local authority has failed to take sufficient account of accessibility to disabled persons of the polling stations within a polling place.

Representations based on any other premise will not be considered. The representation should include the location and any other relevant information regarding the polling place at issue, stating specifically why it is inaccessible or does not meet the reasonable requirements of the electors.
