

West Lothian Council Environmental Health and Trading Standards

Schedule of Charges 2011/12

Overview

Environmental Health & Trading Standards administers the regulatory function relating to a number of licence and registration approvals. The service also delivers a wide variety of commercial services to business. The following document outlines the charging structure for these functions and services.

Services

Unless otherwise specified, services charges will be based on a chargeable rate of £71 (+ VAT) per hour, subject to a minimum charge of one hour. Services delivered out-with core hours will be charged an appropriate additional sum for overtime. The charge includes costs associated with supply, maintenance and calibration of EH&TS equipment where appropriate with the exception of specialist weigh-bridge equipment, which will incur an additional fee where the service has to hire equipment on an hourly or daily rate.

Services available include, but are not restricted to –

- Examination, testing, certifying, stamping, authorising or reporting on weighing or measuring equipment, e.g.
 - Automatic or totalising weighing machines,
 - Equipment designed to weigh loads in motion,
 - Bulk fuel measuring equipment tested following a Regulation 65 or 66 occurrence,
 - Measuring Instruments for Liquid Fuel and Lubricants,
 - Road Tanker Fuel Measuring Equipment (Above 100 Litres).
- Former petroleum tanks site history search
- Food Export Health Certificates - £ 66 per certificate
- Duplicate Food Export Health Certificates requested with original - £6
- Duplicate Food Export Health Certificates requested after original issued - £12
- Immigration Letters (Housing inspections) - £ 71

Work in default of a Defective Building Notice (administration and contract tender) - 10% of the contract price (inc VAT), up to a maximum of £1000.

Pest Control - Treatment Charge Rate for Non Domestic (Commercial) Premises £30 per hour (+ VAT) plus minimum pesticides charge of £6.00/Treatment (where used).
