The Service

The West Lothian Community Rehabilitation & Brain Injury Service is funded by Lothian Health & West Lothian Council. The Team provides assessment and rehabilitation for adults in West Lothian.

Eligibility

You may be eligible for referral to the Service if you:

- Are over the age of 16 years
- Have a physical disability and / or an acquired brain injury.
- Need the services of 2 or more therapies i.e. Speech and Language Therapy, Physiotherapy, Occupational Therapy, and Psychology.
- However we will accept referrals for people with an acquired brain injury who need 1 or more therapies.

The team is based in the Ability Centre, Carmondean, however the service is provided in your own home or community setting.

What we offer

Assessment

- We will visit you to carry out an assessment

- We will identify with you your main difficulties and areas you may wish to work on

This may include:

- Activities of Daily Living (e.g. personal care, household tasks, eating)
- Mobility
- Communication
- Learning & applying knowledge (i.e. memory, problem solving)
- Emotional state (anxiety, depression, adjustment)
- Social activity
- Leisure and work
- Community living (e.g. money management, shopping, travel)

Following this assessment, depending on your needs, we can offer:

- Further specialist assessment
- A rehabilitation programme delivered at home or in your local community
- Advice and information
- Referral to other agencies
- Carer advice / support

The Service is delivered to you free of charge.
