registers for Armadale School, School Board minutes for Linlithgow Academy and records of St Columba's Primary School. Admission registers give personal information about individual pupils, whereas logbooks are daily

diaries of events, usually recording staff absences, cases of illnesses and other notable occurrences. Although many of the recent archives are closed under Data Protection, the majority of school records are open to the public.
