Introduce more opportunities to recycle glass	In 2014 West Lothian Council embarked on a project to introduce 200 new glass recycling sites across West Lothian. By the end of 2014 over 100 of these where in place with the remainder to by introduced throughout 2015. This has also taken away the need for another household recycling bin which was something that you told us you didn't want.
Increase the products which can be recycled within the Blue Bin	A new Blue Bin contract was introduced last year which has increased the products which can now be recycled through the blue bin including plastic bags and a variety of plastic food containers
Provide more opportunities to recycle	Following a successful trial in 2013 the service rolled out the food waste recycling servicer to all households in West Lothian in the Autumn of 2014
