



# How to Guide West Lothian eBooks and eTalking Books

eBooks and eTalking Books are available free of charge to library members and can be used on many devices, such as phones, tablets, computers and eReaders.

**You only need to register once with BorrowBox to use eBooks and eTalking Books.**

If you are not already a member of West Lothian Libraries, pop into your local library with two items of ID (one with your name and address and a second piece of ID with your name) and join up. Please note that you will still have to visit your library with ID to activate your membership.



Your PIN is usually set as the last four digits of your telephone number. Then click Sign In. 




