YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION AND HOW IT WILL BE USED

Under data protection law, the lawful basis we rely on for processing this information is:

HOW LONG DO WE KEEP YOUR INFORMATION AND WHO WILL WE SHARE IT WITH?

WE COLLECT	WILL BE KEPT FOR	WHO WE WILL SHARE IT WITH AND WHY
Your Name and contact details.	We will keep personal information relating to your request for a maximum of six years after your request and any appeal associated with your request has been answered.	The council will not share your information with any third party unless you ask us to do so such as, where you have made an appeal to the Scottish Information Commissioner. Where this is the case, we will share information relating to your request with them in order for them to carry out their investigation. We will not otherwise share your information unless we are required to do so by law.

YOUR RIGHTS

Under data protection law, you have rights including:

Your right of access	You have the right to ask us for copies of your personal information.	
Your right to rectification	You have the right to ask us to rectify personal information you think is inaccurate. You also have the right to ask us to complete information you think is incomplete.	
Your right to erasure	You have the right to ask us to erase your personal information in limited circumstances.

Your right to restriction of processing	You have the right to ask us to restrict the processing of your personal information in certain circumstances.
Your right to object to processing	You have the the right to object to the processing of your personal information in certain circumstances
Your right to data portability	You have the right to ask that we transfer the personal information you gave us to another organisation, or to you, in certain circumstances.

You are not required to pay any charge for exercising your rights. If you make a request, we have one month to respond to you.
