#### **REVIEW OF POLLING DISTRICTS AND PLACES 2018/2019**

### What is the review about?

West Lothian Council has a duty to review all polling districts, places and stations within the 16 month period commencing on 1 October 2018, and will start this review on **3 December 2018**. The council must ensure that all electors have reasonable facilities for voting and we must also make sure that, as far as is reasonable and practicable, the polling places are accessible to all electors including those who are disabled.
