ANNUAL REPORT FOR 2022 - 23

OVERVIEW

West Lothian Development Trust (WLDT) was established to administer community benefit money received from wind farm developments in West Lothian. The fund supports communities and projects located or operating within 10km of any wind farm development.

The trust is comprised of members from the communities within 10km of the developments, West Lothian Council, and the windfarm developers. The adopted community benefit policy states that 70% of all funding received by the trust will be spent in communities within 5km of that windfarm development, and the remaining 30% will be spent within 10km.

The fund supports projects which meet one or more of the following priorities:

- Relieve poverty, advance education or social purposes beneficial to an eligible community.
- Promote and encourage environmental improvement or enhancement.
- Secure investment, create employment, implement training, promote or secure sustainable development.
- Provide or assist in the provision of renewable energy.

In the financial Year **2022-23** the trust administered five grant funds; Blacklaw, Pateshill, Harburnhead, PearieLaw and Tormywheel. All grant funds have two strands of funding; a small grants fund of up to £2,000 and a main grants fund of up to £25,000. A maximum of 70% intervention rate applies to the main grants.

TO DATE THE WEST LOTHIAN DEVELOPMENT TRUST HAS RECEIVED £2,749,194.77 IN FUNDING FROM THE FIVE OPERATIONAL WINDFARMS.

IN 2022-23 THE WEST LOTHIAN DEVELOPMENT TRUST RECEIVED £369,233.35 OF FUNDING FROM FIVE WIND FARMS AND DISTRIBUTED £379,923.29

INFO ON ANNUALLY FUNDED ORGANISATIONS

THE WEST LOTHIAN DEVELOPMENT TRUST PROVIDES FUNDING ANNUALLY DIRECTLY TO TWO ORGANISATIONS THROUGH COMMUNITY BENEFIT RECEIVED FROM PEARIELAW AND BLACKLAW. IN 2022/23 WEST CALDER AND HARBURN COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT TRUST RECEIVED £32,375.37 AND FAULDHOUSE AND BREICH VALLEY COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT TRUST RECEIVED £47,000 AS AN ANNUAL PAYMENT.

BELOW IS SUMMARY OF SOME OF THE ACTIVITY THAT WAS UNDERTAKEN AS A RESULT OF THE FUNDING PROVIDED TO BOTH ORGANISATIONS.

WEST CALDER AND HARBURN COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT TRUST - £32,375.37

West Calder and Harburn Community Development Trust has primarily used the community benefit receive in 2022/23 of £32,375.37 to fund the organisations core staff. The staff have levered in around £370,000 in additional funding in the last year; managed the Community Woods & Garden: Polbeth and West Calder project and developed a long-term plan for its development; managed and developed, in partnership with West Calder Community Education Association, the local community café and food delivery project - The Brunch Club; oversaw delivery of a range of popular community events (including West Lothians largest free-entry fireworks display); supported Easter Breich Woodland Community Group in its first year of ownership of the woodland; provided funding and support for a number of local community projects and secured £3.5million in funding to support the development of The Scottish Cooperative Discovery Centre. The West Calder and Harburn Community Development Trust takes its priority activities from its local Community Action Plan as its guiding strategic document. The organisation seeks to efficiently utilise the core community benefits receive from the West Lothian Development Trust to operate as a capable and effective community anchor organisation with the ability to lever in additional funding and investment into the community, design and deliver specific projects and support others in delivering projects and services. This approach will continue in 2023/24.

FAULDHOUSE AND BREICH VALLEY COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT TRUST - £47,000

Fauldhouse and Breich Valley Community development Trust receives £47,000 in 2022/23. The funding has been used to provide match funds for Fauldhouse and Breich Valley CDT's managers posts at the Hub and at Eastfield Development Centre. The funding has enabled the Trust to promote and establish a wide range of community groups, projects, and initiatives. Fauldhouse and Breich Valley CDT has, through outreach and partnership working, developed strong working relationships with individuals, community groups, local business, and partner organisations. The post holders have worked closely with the Board and assisted them to develop and deliver their business plan and work towards achieving their Social Enterprise Outcomes. They have overseen the management and support of all the CDT's projects. This currently includes, The Community Hub, Eastfield Development Centre, Youth Groups, Benhar Forest and Ponds Project, Mining Tribute Project, the Communications Project, a wide range of Anti-Poverty Advice and Information Support Services and Resources, and the emerging Community Gardens and Village Improvement Projects.

The Asset Transfer of the Eastfield Development Centre has been secured and a wide range of projects and initiatives are now operating from the centre, with more plans to redevelop.

The post holders have helped to manage the finances of the organisation including budget setting, project development and administration, and reporting.

The funding has enabled the Fauldhouse and Breich Valley CDT to develop the programme in both community owned centres, the Hub and Eastfield Development Centre. In 2023/24 the focus will be on further developing the community led programmes and implementing our Social Enterprise Initiatives.

WHITBURN AND DISTRICT COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT TRUST -SUPPORTING OUR COMMUNITY

Whitburn and District Community Development Trust is a Scottish Charity and Company Limited by Guarantee. The Trust was formed in 2009 and is managed by a board or trustees made up of local people. The Trust is the anchor organisation for community development in Whitburn.

They provide services to tackle and alleviate disadvantage through their Community Support Hub, Community Fridge and Community Garden. In January 2023 Whitburn CDT, through their Supporting our Community application were awarded £24,995, to continue delivery of services through their existing projects that support the Whitburn community across the key themes of food poverty and insecurity; welfare advice, employability support and support place-based community wealth building, in collaboration with West Lothian Council.

FOOD TRAIN LTD - EAT WELL BUDDY (EWB)

Food Train supports around 300 local older people to remain in their own home for as long as possible. Their services are delivered by a dedicated team of outstanding volunteers who are supported and trained by their Development Officers.

The project available to Food Train Shopping Service customers:

- ·assesses individual's nutrition
- ·identify those at risk of malnutrition, and
- •provides a 1-to-1 volunteer support service for those people requiring greater support with weekly meal and snack planning, shopping planning and food fortification.

As the Eat Well Buddy project has developed, staff have noted the positive impact of signposting for our members and have developed the initial project to include a more robust signposting service.

In January 2023 The Food Train Ltd were awarded £15,000 for the continued development of their Eat Well Buddy initiative, which aims to support clients on a one to one basis to access fresh varied diet.

FAULDHOUSE AND BREICH VALLEY COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT TRUST LTD COMMUNICATION PROJECT

Fauldhouse and Breich Valley Community Development Trust were established in 2006 and work in the community to address the social, economic, environmental, physical issues and concerns whilst also supporting community aspirations.

They provide services and resources which address the mental health and well-being of those living within their community and also provide advice, information, advocacy, sign posting, opportunities for sport, recreation, arts and drama.

In March 2023 the community development trust was awarded £25,000 for the communication coordinator post within the organisation. Fauldhouse and Breich Valley Community Development Trust has seen substantial growth in its projects, activities, events, and social enterprise initiatives over the previous few years. The grant will enable the current level of communication provision to be sustained and to allow new initiatives to be developed to support the organisations growth.

THE SCHOOL BANK WEST LOTHIAN

IThe School Bank West Lothian provides new and as new school clothing and supplies for children in West Lothian who are affected by poverty. Their aims are to help relieve poverty, enable equal access to education, and afford children dignity and self-respect. They work closely with schools and community groups in areas of high deprivation across West Lothian, such as Addiewell, Blackburn, Craigshill, Fauldhouse and Whitburn.

During the 12 months until end of April 2022 they supported 1,344 children with a school uniform pack, which equates to an increase of 32% on the previous year and provided over 700 uniform packs for children returning to school in August 2022.

25% of children in West Lothian live in poverty after housing costs which is an increase of 4.3% since 2015. The West Lothian Development Trust eligible areas include some of the most deprived in the region and approximately 53% of all the children the organisation assists attend schools within the WLDT eligible areas.

The School Bank West Lothian were awarded £21,000 in November 2022 to support the continuation of their core service, plus the additional projects they have launched including:

The introduction of a self-referral scheme to ensure those who need their service can access it directly and are set up on the FORT system for this purpose and are supported by the Advice Shop to operate this scheme; and Developed links with several schools to support the introduction of uniform hubs to allow families a way to access support directly from the school.

WEST CALDER HIGH SCHOOL PARENT COUNCIL SEVEN A SIDE GOALPOST FOR THE ARTIFICIAL PITCH AT THE HIGH SCHOOL

The West Calder High School Parent Council fulfils the role of link between parents and pupils of the High School and the local school management whilst supporting activities at the school that benefit the wider community.

In September 2022 the group were given an award of £3,642 towards the purchase of three sets of seven a side folding goals sitting sideways on the pitch which will provide 3 playable/training spaces.

The provision of the goals will double the number of people using the pitch at the same time and create a high-quality training facility for use by pupils, adults and also local football clubs. It will also support usage by people for whom a full-size pitch is not a viable option.

FALLA HILL PARENT COUNCIL BUILDING OUR SCHOOL AND COMMUNITY

Falla Hill Parent Council work all side the school, the pupils, parents and the community to support the development of the school community.

In January 2023 they were awarded a small grant of £2,000 towards improvements at the infant playground through a retaining wall built to stop dirt and rubble washing onto the tarmac area. The retaining wall has concrete block seating off it, creating an immovable and indestructible area for children to find quiet away from the central play area.
